

Maths in Reception

At the end of one year in Reception class, MOST children should be able to:

- Count past 10 with other children
- Count on from small numbers
- Count at least 10 things on my own
- Look at 2 groups of things (up to 10) and say which has more and which has less
- Say who is first, second and third in a line
- Make a group with one more or one less in it when I am shown a group of objects
- Guess how many things there are and see if they're right by counting them
- Recognise numbers up to 10
- Write numbers up to 5
- Read and order numbers up to 10
- Write numbers up to 10, mostly the right way round
- Add using a set of objects
- Take away using a set of objects
- Use 1p coins in shop play

Some children will ALSO be able to:

- Count, read, write and order numbers 1-10
- Count 15 objects
- Count on and back from small numbers
- Solve adding and take away problems and explain how they did it
- Use a number line to work things out
- Count in 10s from 0
- Say the number one more or one less than a number 0-30
