Specialist Support	Dyslexia teacher, Occupational Therapy (OT) and Speech therapy (SLT), Learning Mentor/Pastoral Care and Play Therapists
Maths Support	Maths classes differentiated 3 ways to enable smaller classes and more one-to-one teaching.
Outdoor learning and trips	PPG funded when necessary
Clubs	PPG funded when necessary
Impact of Actions:	
80% of PPG pupils to achieve ARE in reading at KS2	<p>We looked at the different year groups and although we did not meet our ambitious targets we continue to work towards them.</p> <p>Year 6 had 15 PP children 66% reached ARE or above</p> <p>Year 5 had 9 children 78% reached ARE or above</p> <p>Year 4 had 7 children 72%reached ARE or above</p> <p>Year 3 had 7 children 86% reached ARE or above</p> <p>Year 2 had 13 children 77% reached ARE or above</p>
