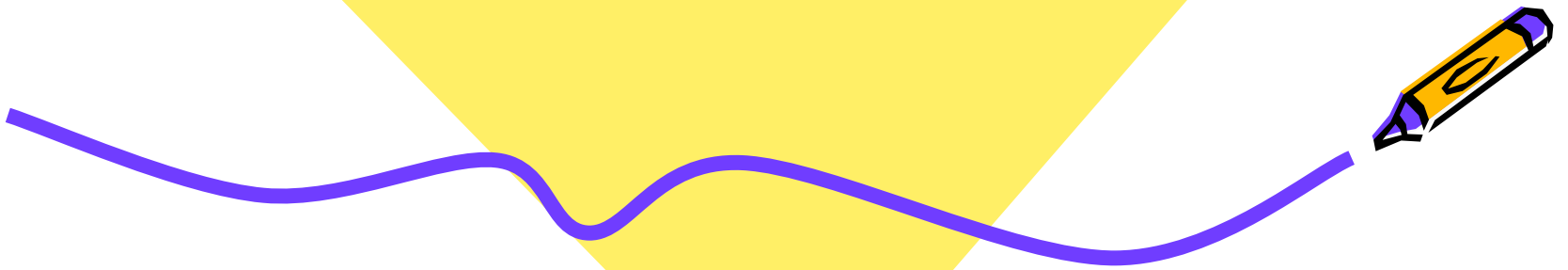

# Need to know...

## Clothing

- Optional uniform

# What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?

The Early Years Foundation Stage (E.Y.F.S.) is the stage of education for children from **birth** to the **end of the Reception year**.

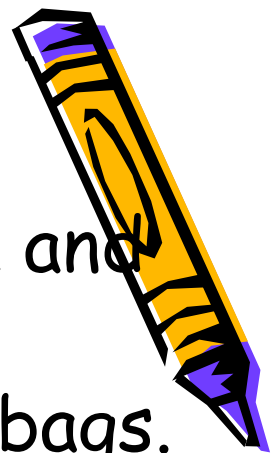
It is based on the recognition that children learn best through **play** and **active learning**.

This is a very important stage as it helps your child get ready for school as well as preparing them for their future learning and successes. From when your child is born up until the age of 5, their early years experience should be happy, active, exciting, fun and secure; and support their development, care and learning needs.



# Reading Books

- Children will start off with a reading book and a free choice book. The books must be brought to school every day in their book bags.
- You will be given a Reading Record book to write comments in, when you read a book with your child.
- Book bags are available from the office.



# The first few weeks

We will find out what the children already know and can do and use this information to help us understand your child's needs.



You will be invited to discuss your child's progress & adjustment to school within the first term at parents evening.
