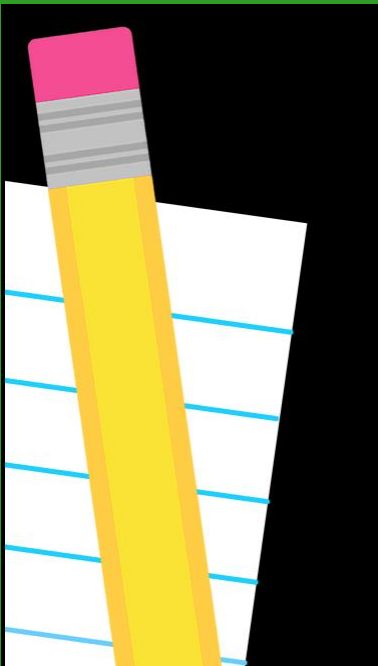

Independence

Punctuality & Attendance

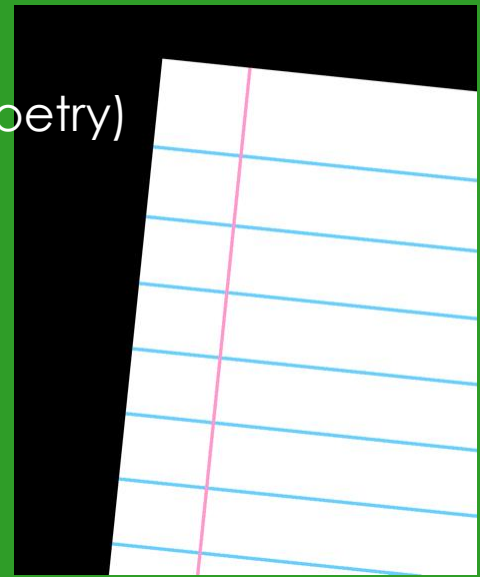
- Children must be at school for 9.00 am when the back gate in Welham Road will be open for the children to come in.

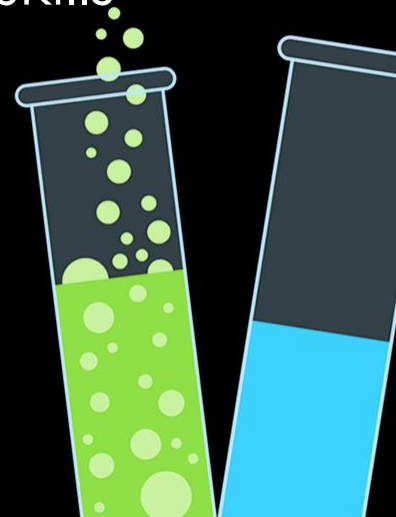

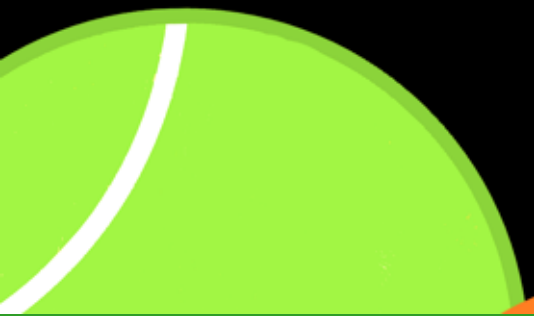
Science

- Topics covered in Year 3 include:
 - Plants
 - Animals including Humans
 - Rocks
 - Light
 - Forces and Magnets
- There is an emphasis on scientific enquiry skills and questioning



PE

- At the moment, children will have one outdoor games session.
- Dance lessons will take place in the classroom.
- We also try to include an extra 10 minutes of physical activity a day.
- It would be useful for the children to have trainers in school if they don't normally wear them.
- We will resume swimming and indoor gymnastics as soon as this is considered safe.



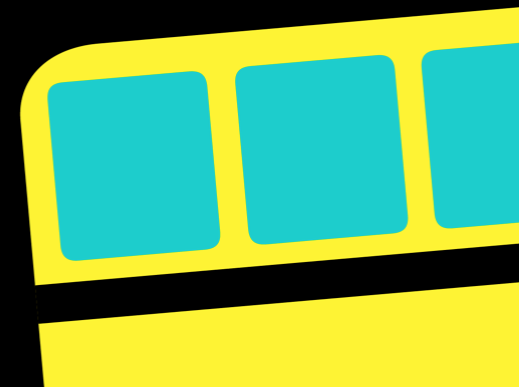
Recorders
