

Frequently asked questions

1. Does the school provide after school care?

Yes, we have an extended provision coordinator who organises the care. We have our own staff and only take children from this school. It is available until 6:00pm. There is a separate provision for the Nursery and Reception children. We can take up to 30 children. There is a charge, payable in advance and a waiting list

2. Is there a breakfast club?

Yes, it is a drop in club from 7:30 normally. Cost £2 daily.

3. Do you have after school activity clubs?

There is a changing range of clubs open to specific year groups on a daily basis. They normally run until 4pm. There is a charge payable in advance.

4. What is the school uniform?

Grey and green and optional. The school uniform is on display in the reception foyer and an order form is available from reception for you to purchase the uniform when your child attends the play dates with their new class before the September in which they start.

5. Where do the children eat lunch?

The children normally go to the dining hall to eat.

6. What languages do you teach?

French is taught to all classes from the summer term in year one.

7. What is staff turnover like?

Staff turnover is very low. The vast majority of staff are very long serving, experienced teachers and support staff who have worked here for several years.

8. How are special needs children supported?

All classes have teaching assistants and teachers who support children who need some extra help; as well as access to 2 Learning mentors, an occupational health assistant and a speech and language assistant.

The school employs a specialist dyslexia teacher and has support from the visual and hearing impairment services. We have support from 2 educational psychologists and we use soundfield systems in all classes.

9. What is the behaviour like in school?

Children treat each other respectfully and are encouraged to behave kindly. Behaviour is very good.

10. What sports do you teach?

We have a specialist sports teacher for outdoor sports who teaches across the year groups. All the teachers also teach dance and gym and normally all children have weekly swimming lessons from year one.

11. What specialist teachers do you have?

We have dedicated specialist rooms and staff for Music and Art. All children access these subjects weekly.
